章节摘录

The Beijing-Shanghai High-speed Railway is a project with the most investment and technology content in the Medium- and Long-term Program for the Railway Network approved by the State Council in early 2004. It is the first high-speed railway meeting advanced international standards in China. It runs 1,318 km, almost parallel to the existing Beijing-Shanghai Railway. In the future, the Beijing-Shanghai High-speed Railway will be used specially for passenger transport, while the Beijing-Shanghai Railway will be used mainly for freight transport. The Beijing-Shanghai High-speed Railway is a double-track one with a planned speed of 350 kph, and 300 kph during the earlier period of its service. The line will have 21 stations when it is completed and put into operation in 2010. By that time, it will take only five hours from Beijing to Shanghai (about nine hours shorter than the present journey) and it will carry 80 million passengers each way a year. Moreover, the trains leave at short intervals, with one train running every three minutes during peak time. The Beijing-Shanghai High-speed Railway will use high-speed wheel track technology, over 70 percent of which has been developed by China itself. According to the Medium- and Long-term Program for the Railway Network, by 2020 the length of railway lines in service will have increased from 73,000 km at the end of 2003 to 100,000 km. Busy arteries will have separate passenger and freight lines, and double-track and electric railways will reach 50 percent of the total.
