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前言

《新闻英语视听说》（全新版）是依照教育部2007年7月颁布实施的《大学英语课程教学要求》编写的一套高级新闻英语视听说教材，适用于大学英语较高或更高要求阶段、研究生英语阶段和其他高级英语阶段的学习者。

全新版教材在2004年出版的第1版教材的基础上更新了听力素材，使之更具时代感。

同时，对练习进行了重新编排，从而更好地满足新闻英语的教学需求。

《新闻英语视听说》（全新版）取材于近年来欧美澳主要英语国家各大电视媒体的公开放送内容，目的是帮助大学生熟悉和掌握各种新闻英语的特点，进一步培养和提高英语语言技能，从而听懂英语国家的广播电视节目，及时了解现代资讯，灵活自如地使用英语进行国际沟通。

《新闻英语视听说》（全新版）教程视听一体、内容新颖、题材广泛、语言规范、实用性和趣味性极强。

本教程配有约4小时的原声剪辑光盘，音质优美，以现代美语为主，并涉及不同的英语变体。

本教程着力于提高学习者的新闻英语视听技能和口语表达能力，注重前沿资讯、国际交流、风俗习惯、文化背景等知识，以适应不同场合的英语视听任务和口语交际活动。

《新闻英语视听说》（全新版）共有16个主题单元，涉及政治、经济、文化、教育、娱乐、体育、科技、自然等方面；形式多样、内容丰富，基本满足各种情形下的新闻英语需求。

本教程所有视听材料均有注解、听力脚本和中文翻译，练习配有参考答案，以便学习者自主学习和课堂任务检查。

教程注重在语言、内容和语体等方面由浅入深、循序渐进，教师和学习者可根据具体情况进行适当调整，有目的、有选择地使用本教程内容。

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内容概要

本教材在第一版的基础上更新了听力内容并重新设计了练习，使之更适合新闻英语的教学需求。教材共有16个主题单元，涉及政治、经济、文化、教育、娱乐、体育、科技、自然等方面，所有视听材料均有注解、听力脚本和中文翻译，练习配有参考答案，以便学习者自主学习和课堂任务检查。

本教材取材于近年来欧美澳主要英语国家各大电视媒体的公开放送内容，配有约4小时的原声MP3录音光盘，目的是帮助大学生熟悉和掌握各种新闻英语的特点，进一步培养和提高英语语言技能，从而灵活自如地使用英语进行国际沟通。

本教材适用于大学英语较高或更高要求阶段、研究生英语阶段和其他英语阶段的学习者。

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The Hudson River is a river rising in the Adirondack Mountains of northeast New York and flowing about 507 km (315 miles) generally southward to Upper New York Bay at New York City. Giovanni da Verrazano first sighted the river in 1524, but it was not explored until Henry Hudson's 1609 voyage. New Jersey Palisades or the Hudson Palisades are a line of steep cliffs along the west side of the lower Hudson River in northeast New Jersey and southern New York in the United States. The cliffs are among the most dramatic geologic features in the vicinity of New York City, forming a canyon of the Hudson north of Fort Lee, as well as providing a dramatic vista of the New York City skyline from the opposite bank of the Hudson. The George Washington Bridge

(known informally as the GW Bridge, the GWB, the GW, or the George) is a suspension bridge spanning the Hudson River, connecting the Washington Heights neighborhood in the borough of Manhattan in New York City to Fort Lee in New Jersey. The GW span is the fourth largest suspension bridge in the United States. The Brooklyn Bridge, one of the oldest suspension bridges in the United States, stretches 5,989 feet (1825 m) over the East River connecting the New York City boroughs of Manhattan and Brooklyn. On completion, it was the largest suspension bridge in the world and the first steel-wire suspension bridge. Since its opening, it has become an iconic part of the New York skyline. The Golden Gate Bridge is a suspension bridge spanning the Golden Gate, the opening of the San Francisco Bay onto the Pacific Ocean. It has the second longest suspension bridge main span in the United States. In 2007, it was ranked fifth on the List of America's Favorite Architecture by the American Institute of Architects.

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
