版权页：插图：2.(1) The use of alliteration. Each full line has four stresses with a number of unstressed syllables, three of which begin with the same sound or letter. (2) The use of the strong stress and the predominance of consonants. Almost all this poetry is composed without rhyme. Each line is divided into two halves and each half has two heavy stresses. (3) The use of vivid poetic diction and parallel expressions for a single idea, such as the sea is called "swan-road" or "whale-path", a soldier is called "shield-bearer", "battle'hero" or "spear-fighter", etc. 3. (1) Chaucer's language is vivid and exact. His words are easy to understand. (2) He introduced from France the "heroic couplet" to English poetry. (3) Though influenced by French, and Italian literature models, he is the first important poet to write in the current English language. His production of so much excellent poetry was an important factor in establishing English as the literary language of the country. 4. The romance was the prevailing form of literature in the Middle Ages. It was a long composition, sometimes in verse, sometimes in prose, used to sing knightly adventures or other heroic deeds. Its essential features are: (1) The central character of the romance is the knight, a man of noble birth skilled in the use of weapons. He is commonly described as riding forth to accomplish some missions—to protect the church, to attack infidelity, to rescue a maiden, to meet a challenge or to obey a knightly command. (2) Romantic love is an important part of the plot in the romance.
