章节摘录

In 1960 - 1961, Chad harvested 9,800 tons of cotton seed for the first time in its history, and put out the flag a little too soon. The efforts of the authorities to get the peasants "back" to work, asthey bad slacked off a great deal the previous year during independence celebrations, largely con-tributed to it. Also, rains were well spaced, and continued through the whole month of October. If the 1961 - 1962 total is back to the region of 45,000 tons, it is mostly because efforts slackened again and sowing was started too late. The average date of sowing is about July 1st. If this date is simply moved up fifteen or twenty days, 30,000 to 60,000 tons of cotton are gained, depending on the year. The peasant in Chad sows his millet first, and it is hard to critidze this instinctive priority given to his " daily bread ". An essential rea-son for his lateness with sowing cotton is that at the time when he should leave to prepare the fields he hasjust barely sold the cotton of the previous season. The work required to sow, in great heat, is psychologi-cally far more difficult if one 's lockets are full of money. The date of cotton sales sluld therefore bemoved forward as much as possible, and purchases of equipment and draught animals encouraged. should also be encouraged to save money, to help them through the difficult period betweenharvests. If necessary they should be forced to do so, by having the payments for cotton given to them ininstallments. The last payment would be made after proof that the peasant has planted beforethe deadline, the date being advanced to the end of June. Those who have done so would receive extramoney whereas the last planters would not receive their last Only the first steps are hard, because once work has started the peasants continue willingly payment until later. on theirway. Educational campaigns among the peasants will play an essential role in this basic advance, earlysowing, on which all the others depend. It is not a matter of mntmUing the peasants. Each peasant willremain master of his fields. One could, however, suggest the need for the time being of kind but firmrule, which, as long as it cannot be realized "by the people", should at least be "for the people."
