Is encouraged to memorize. Examinations do not motivate a student to read widely , but to restrict his reading ; they do not enable him to seek more and more knowledge , but induce cramming. They lower the standards of teaching , for they deprive the teacher of all freedom. Teachers themselves are often judged by examination results and instead of teaching their subjects , they are reduced to training their students in exam techniques which they despise. The most successful candidates are not always the best educated ; they are trained in the technique of working under duress . The results on which so much depends are often nothing more than a subjective assessment by some anonymous examiners. Examiners are only human. They get tired and hungry ; they make mistakes. Yet they have to mark stacks of hastily scrawled scripts in a limited amount of time. They work under the same sort of pressure as the candidates. And their word carries weight. After a judge ' s decision you have the right of appeal , but not after an examiner ' s. There must surely be many simpler and more effective ways of assessing a person ' s true abilities. Is it cynical to suggest that examinations are merely a profitable business for the institutions that run them ?

This is what it boils down to in the last analysis. The best comment on the system is this illiterate message recently scrawled on a wall : “ I were a teenage drop-out and now I am a teenage millionaire. ”
