前言

《新编大学英语快速阅读》系列教材是一套依据最新的教学理念，以最新的素材结合《大学英语课程教学要求（试行）》而编写的供大学英语快速阅读教学使用的教材。

本教材基于信息时代阅读量大的背景，结合《大学英语课程教学要求（试行）》所要求的阅读速度，从第一册至第四册循序渐进地设计编写，尽量避免生僻词汇影响阅读速度，而完全注重于阅读技能的培养和提高，这也是本教材区别于其他同类教材的亮点。

在难度安排上，本教材避免了传统的根据文章难易度排列的模式，而是根据对相近难易度文章的不同阅读速度的要求来安排，使之更符合快速阅读的教学理念。

在习题的设计上，本教材参考了《大学英语四级考试大纲（2006修订版）》中快速阅读的习题模式，使学生在参加此类考试时能轻车熟路，少走弯路。

本教材第一版在上海大学等多家综合性大学及专科院校使用，受到相关师生的一致好评，荣获“教育部推荐使用大学外语类教材”，此次由原班编写人马，倾力再造，对之加以完善，以期更符合中国一般高等院校的教学实际，而不是供少数精英学校使用的阳春白雪版本。

由于作者知识面所限，教材中难免有疏漏，望老师和同学们不吝指正。
