内容概要

The contributions of China's commerce development to the world economy are becoming increasingly prominent. Mr. Rubens Ricupero, Former Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, held that China and U.S. were two big locomotives of the world economy in respect of trade. China contributed to approximately 12% of the growth of global trade in goods in the three years since its accession to the World Trade Organization. And China has become the first driver to the growth of the world trade with the continuous enlargement of China's domestic consumption. China has become a market with the greatest potential for many countries to which their export increased most rapidly. Last year, the net increment of China's import value reached USD 148.5 billion. China also supplied a large quantity of inexpensive consumer goods of fine quality to the world, and its export value reached USD 593.3 billion, which greatly reduced the expenditures of the importing countries, and improved the welfares of consumers in respect of investment. A group of new laws and regulations on commerce were formulated in the past year, and the investment environment was further improved. China has become a fairyland for the investors around the world. According to the statistics, from 1990 to 2004, the profits remitted abroad by foreign-funded enterprises in China reached USD 250.6 billion. It is estimated that the profit rate of foreign-funded industrial enterprises in China were approximately 6.6%.
